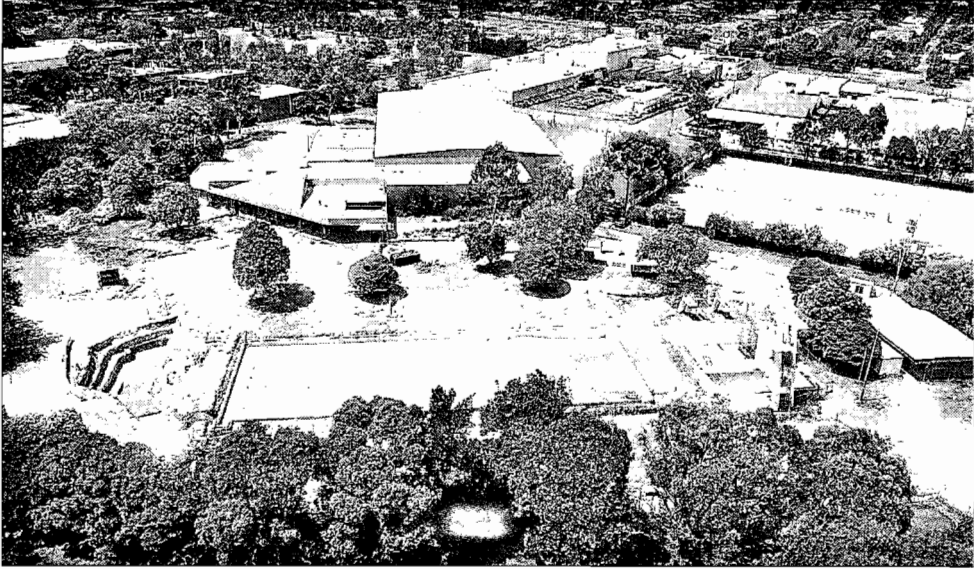
The demolition works associated with the old change rooms,
